Tompkins High School. He served honorably in the United States Army during the Vietnam Era. He retired as SGT.

Ashley received several awards: Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal w/Device 1960, Vietnam Services Medal, National Defense Service Medal and Combat Infantryman Badge
