SAVANNAH - Ms. Carolyn Brenda Gadson, 67 entered eternal rest on early Tuesday morning, January 12, 2021 surrounded by her loving family. She was the tenth child born to Elder Horace and Sister Bethel Gadson in Savannah, Georgia on June 23, 1953. She received her education in the local schools of Chatham County and was a graduate of Sophronia Tompkins High School, Class of 1972. She further her studies at Savannah State University (now Savannah State University). At an early age, she was baptized at Oakland Baptist Church, Savannah, GA. and later moved her membership to West Broad Street Seventh Day Adventist Church where she served faithfully as a Deaconess and Sabbath School Teacher until her health began to decline.
