



## Sis. Catherine Katrina Hall

November 20, 1953 - December 13, 2021

SAVANNAH - Sister Catherine Katrina "Kay" Hood Hall , 68 wife of Cordell Hall passed away peacefully, Monday, December 13, 2021 at her residence surrounded by her loving family. Katrina was born on November 20, 1953 to the late Mr. Charlie L. Hood Jr. and Mrs. Sarah Dean Rolf Hood. She received her Elementary School education in the following cities, Columbus and Savannah, Georgia. Katrina was a 1971 graduate of A. E. Beach High School of Savannah, Georgia and received her undergraduate BS Degree for Elementary Education from Savannah State (College) University in June of 1975. She was an Elementary School teacher for a couple of years, then made a career change to U. S. Postal Service in the city of Savannah, Georgia where she worked until transferring to Alexandria, Virginia and there continuing her Postal Service career until retirement.

On November 3, 1984 Katrina married Mr. Cordell a God-fearing man, a marriage ordained by God for 37 years. From this marriage she gained two step-daughters; Mrs. Bridgette (Julian) Treadwell and Ms NeShon Williams, three grandsons; David Williams Jr., DeShaw Williams and Nicholas Van Treadwell.

Katrina was a faithful member of the Churches of Christ. She worshipped at several congregations; 50th Street Church of Christ, Savannah, GA, Mount Vernon Church of Christ, Alexandria, VA, Liberty Church of Christ, Savannah, GA and Bellfort Church of Christ, Houston, TX.

Katrina was predeceased by her eldest brother Mr. Charlie L. Hood III. In addition to her husband, step-daughters and grandsons, she leaves to cherish her memories three very protective brothers; Joseph, Jasper and Anthony Hood, seven loving nieces; Chenay Hood-Phoenix, Lakisha and Latrece Hood, Rashita Edwards, Leslie Bostic, Sarah Hood and Sha'Daya Hood Brown, three awesome nephews; Jasper Hood Jr., Anwaar and Alim Hood, her best cook ever aunt Mrs. Brenda Hood, a host of loving cousins, three God Children and two grand God Children; Brother and Sister In Laws, Pastor Gilbert Hall, Sr., Cheryl Hall Woodson, Horace Hall, Sr. (Vanessa), France Hall Graham (Carlton), and Marie Hall; other extended family, beautiful friends and her church family.

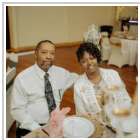
