He was educated in the public schools of Muscogee and Chatham county. He was a graduate of A. E Beach High School, Class of 1969. He was a former member of St. Philip AME Church and attended Mt. Sinai Baptist Church. He was a veteran of the United States Navy. After Charlie returned home from the Navy, he attended Savannah State College (now University). Later he worked as a Mill Grind Operator for Kemira Industries and retired after many years of service. In 2011 he was inducted in the A.E. Beach High School Athletic Hall of Fame for his Basketball and Track athleticism. He loved sports, Motown music, traveling and spending time with his family.
