I watched God Bless Harold, from the trailer park, to a property/home owner, business owner etc.

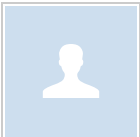
He loved to see people succeed and he wanted the best for everyone. He was always thinking about his family. May God's Peace comfort the family.
