SAVANNAH - Mr. Owoidogho Essien Ukpung, 64 entered eternal rest September 15, 2021 at Saint Joseph's Hospital. Owoidogho was born on February 27, 1957 into the family of late Albert Essien Ukpung and Itaa Mmamma Essien of Ikot Ambang, Akwa Ibom State, Nigeria.

Owoidogho began his formal education at St. Peter's Primary School, Ikot Ambang Nigeria. He attended a Catholic Junior Seminary in Oron and completed at Holy Trinity Secondary School, Mbiakong, Nigeria. He obtained his Ordinary National Diploma (OND) at South Glamorgan Institute, Cardiff, Wales. Owoidogho then went on to study Biochemistry at Suffolk University, Boston where he earned another Bachelor's degree at Massachusetts College of Pharmacy (Now MCPHS University), Boston.

Owoidogho began his historic and eventful career through hard work and diligence, passing the Georgia Pharmacy Board examination to be a Registered Pharmacist. He worked in the State of Georgia for 28 years with Revco Inc. now CVS Pharmacy. He was a member of Freedom Fellowship Church in Savannah.

Owoidogho was an active member serving as a pharmacist at a number of missions of Horizon International Medical Missions to Nigeria, Haiti and other countries. He was a faithful servant of God who was very committed in the
