SAVANNAH - Deacon Walter Isaac Bradley, Jr., age 103, husband of the late Saint Mentoria Bradley passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 19, 2026. He was born in Savannah, Georgia, the son of the late Walter Isaac Bradley Sr. and Edith Walker. He received his early education in Savannah Chatham County School District.

Deacon Bradley joined the United House of Prayer For All People at an early age and was baptized under the leadership of Daddy Grace. As a devout member of the church, he served on many auxiliaries, Business Board, Treasurer, and the Senior Male Usher Board for many years and was the last surviving member.

Deacon Walter Bradley enlisted in the United States Navy in 1943 as Apprentice Seaman. He was honorably discharged after completion of duty. Deacon Bradley was employed at Savannah Chatham County Transportation Department as a bus driver until retirement in 1988.

In addition to his parents, Deacon Walter is preceded in death by his wife, Mentoria L. German-Bradley, Walter and Edith Bradley; two sisters, Velma Russell and Burdell.
