SAVANNAH - Apostle Washington Peeples, Sr., husband of the late Saint Betty Jean Peeples passed away peacefully at the age of 92 on Friday, October 3, 2014 with his loving family by his side at The Place at Pooler under the care of Gentiva Hospice. He was born in Estill, SC and educated in the local schools in Savannah and McIntosh County. He retired from the Savannah Sugar Refinery after 33 years of service. He was a WWII veteran where he served in the U.S. Navy. He was a charter member of the United House of Prayer for All People. During his life as an Elder he served as youth pastor in Columbia, SC, and assistant pastor in Winston Salem, NC. He also served as pastor in Portal, GA and Scotia, SC for ten years. Later, he was appointed to the Elder board at the Savannah Motherhouse (Ogeechee Road).
